She spent five years teaching university in England. As an active member of Carpe Diem Theatre Company, Stratford-upon-Avon, UK, she designed and facilitated workshops throughout England. Her most recent achievement was serving as the rejuvenation campaign leader of Clearfield Arts Studio Theater. Developing the human potential through the performing arts inspires Mary Beth to keep the arts alive through community engagement.

Community engagement is the focus of her interview on The Wire. As the new Arts Manager, Mary Beth aims to create conditions in which local collaborative arts might happen. Cultural Resources Inc.
